## AN ACT

Relating to the responsible vendor program; amending ORS 471.344.

## Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

## **SECTION 1.** ORS 471.344 is amended to read:

471.344. (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall by rule establish a responsible vendor program. The program shall include a list of positive measures that a [retail licensee, as defined in ORS 471.392,] licensee must take to avoid sales of alcoholic beverages to minors. Any [retail licensee] person holding a liquor license that authorizes the person to sell alcoholic beverages at retail may participate in the program.

(2) If a [*retail licensee, as defined in ORS 471.392,*] **licensee** participates in the responsible vendor program [*established under this section, and the licensee*] **and** takes all measures specified by the program as necessary to prevent sales of alcoholic beverages to minors, the commission [*shall*] **may** not cancel the license of the licensee, or deny issuance of a license to the [*person that holds the retail license*] **licensee**, based on sales of alcoholic beverages to minors by employees of the licensee.
