

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2150

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and lines  
2 3 and 4 and insert “amending ORS 471.235.”.

3 Delete lines 6 through 26 and delete pages 2 through 13 and insert:

4 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 471.235 is amended to read:

5 “471.235. (1) A wholesale malt beverage and wine license shall allow the importation, storage,  
6 transportation, wholesale sale and distribution to licensees of the Oregon Liquor Control Commis-  
7 sion, and the export of wine, cider and malt beverages, and the importation and sale to the com-  
8 mission and the export of wine of alcoholic content in excess of 21 percent alcohol by volume. [*No*  
9 *such licensee shall*] **A wholesale malt beverage and wine licensee may not** sell any alcoholic li-  
10 quor for consumption upon the licensed premises. However, a wholesale malt beverage and wine  
11 licensee may sell naturally fermented wine or cider in quantities of not less than four gallons nor  
12 more than 55 gallons at any one time to consumers for consumption not on the licensed premises.  
13 Wholesale malt beverage and wine licensees may sell malt beverages containing not more than  
14 [*eight*] **nine** percent alcohol by volume in quantities not less than [*five*] **four** gallons to any unli-  
15 censed organization, lodge, picnic party or private gathering. [*Such malt beverages shall not be sold*  
16 *by such unlicensed group.*] **The unlicensed organization, lodge, picnic party or private gathering**  
17 **may not sell the malt beverages.** A wholesale malt beverage and wine license shall permit the  
18 licensee also to sell malt beverages at wholesale only, to persons holding licenses authorizing  
19 [*them*] **the persons** to resell such beverages at retail. Employees of wholesale malt beverage and  
20 wine licensees may serve sample tastings of malt beverages, cider and wine at alcoholic beverage  
21 industry trade shows, seminars and conventions and at alcoholic beverage industry sample tastings  
22 for employees of retail licensees.

23 “(2) [*Nothing in*] Subsection (1) of this section [*shall be considered to*] **does not** prohibit the  
24 transportation or wholesale sale or distribution of malt beverage or wine by a wholesale malt  
25 beverage and wine licensee to any alcoholic treatment center licensed by the Oregon Health Au-  
26 thority.

27 “(3) A wholesale malt beverage and wine licensee may impose an additional handling fee on any  
28 wine sold to any retailer in this state if the quantity of wine sold to the retailer is less than the  
29 smallest multiple-package case available to be sold and the handling fee is uniform for all  
30 licensees.”.
