SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Creates [crime] offense of making a false report of child abuse. Punishes by maximum of [one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both] \$720 fine.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 419B.005 to 5 419B.050.

6 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) A person commits the offense of making a false report of child abuse if 7 the person:

8 (a) Makes a false report of child abuse to the Department of Human Services or a law 9 enforcement agency, knowing that the report is false; or

(b) With the intent that a public or private official make a report of child abuse to the
Department of Human Services or a law enforcement agency, makes a false report of child
abuse to the public or private official, knowing that the report is false.

13 (2) Making a false report of child abuse is a Class A violation.
