SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Creates [*crime*] **offense** of making a false report of child abuse. Punishes by maximum of [*one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both*] **\$720 fine.**

2 Relating to reporting of child abuse.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 419B.005 to**
5 **419B.050.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the offense of making a false report of child abuse if**
7 **the person:**

8 (a) **Makes a false report of child abuse to the Department of Human Services or a law**
9 **enforcement agency, knowing that the report is false; or**

10 (b) **With the intent that a public or private official make a report of child abuse to the**
11 **Department of Human Services or a law enforcement agency, makes a false report of child**
12 **abuse to the public or private official, knowing that the report is false.**

13 (2) **Making a false report of child abuse is a Class A violation.**
