Creates offense of making a false report of child abuse. Punishes by maximum of \$720 fine.

4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 419B.005 to
5	419B.050.
6	SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the offense of making a false report of child abuse if,
7	with the intent to influence a custody, parenting time, visitation or child support decision,
8	the person:
9	(a) Makes a false report of child abuse to the Department of Human Services or a law
10	enforcement agency, knowing that the report is false; or
11	(b) With the intent that a public or private official make a report of child abuse to the
12	Department of Human Services or a law enforcement agency, makes a false report of child
13	abuse to the public or private official, knowing that the report is false.
14	(2) Making a false report of child abuse is a Class A violation.
