SUMMARY

Creates offense of making a false report of child abuse. Punishes by maximum of \$720 fine.

2 Relating to reporting of child abuse.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 419B.005 to**
5 **419B.050.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the offense of making a false report of child abuse if,**
7 **with the intent to influence a custody, parenting time, visitation or child support decision,**
8 **the person:**

9 **(a) Makes a false report of child abuse to the Department of Human Services or a law**
10 **enforcement agency, knowing that the report is false; or**

11 **(b) With the intent that a public or private official make a report of child abuse to the**
12 **Department of Human Services or a law enforcement agency, makes a false report of child**
13 **abuse to the public or private official, knowing that the report is false.**

14 **(2) Making a false report of child abuse is a Class A violation.**
