## House Bill 2183

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates crime of making a false report of child abuse. Punishes by maximum of one year's imprisonment, \$6,250 fine, or both.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 419B.005 to
5	419B.050.
6	SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the crime of making a false report of child abuse if
7	the person:
8	(a) Makes a false report of child abuse to the Department of Human Services or a law
9	enforcement agency, knowing that the report is false; or
10	(b) With the intent that a public or private official make a report of child abuse to the
11	Department of Human Services or a law enforcement agency, makes a false report of child
12	abuse to the public or private official, knowing that the report is false.
13	(2) Making a false report of child abuse is a Class A misdemeanor.
