House Bill 2213

Sponsored by Representative KOMP (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Allows members of Commission for Women to elect chairperson and vice chairperson. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2 Relating to the Commission for Women; creating new provisions; amending ORS 185.520; and de-

3 claring an emergency.

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4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 185.520 is amended to read:

6 185.520. (1) The membership of the Commission for Women shall be comprised of 11 members, to include two representatives from the Legislative Assembly, one appointed by the President of the 7 8 Senate, one appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. Nine members shall be appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate pursuant to section 4, Article III, Oregon 9 Constitution. To the extent possible, members appointed by the Governor shall provide for repre-10 sentation from all areas of the state. All of the members of the commission shall be residents of this 11 12 state. (2) Members appointed by the Governor shall serve for three-year terms. Legislators shall serve 13two-year terms. 14

15 [(3) The Governor shall designate the chairperson of the commission to serve for a term of one 16 year.]

(3) The commission members shall elect a chairperson and vice chairperson for terms
of one year and shall determine the duties of the officers.

19 (4) Members shall meet at the call of the chairperson not less than three times annually.

20 (5) Consistent with Oregon law, the commission may receive and accept funds for purposes 21 consistent with the creation of the commission.

22 <u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 185.520 by section 1 of this 2011 Act first apply to 23 the selection of a chairperson or vice chairperson whose term expires or whose office is de-24 clared vacant on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.

25 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 26 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect 27 on its passage.

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
