House Bill 2228

Sponsored by Representative GREENLICK (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits person from carrying child under six years of age on bicycle or in bicycle trailer. Punishes by maximum fine of \$90.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 814.460 is amended to read:
5	814.460. (1) A person commits the offense of unlawful passengers on a bicycle if the person op-
6	erates a bicycle and carries:
7	(a) More persons on the bicycle than the number for which it is designed or safely equipped;
8	or
9	(b) A child under six years of age on the bicycle or in a bicycle trailer.
10	(2) The offense described in this section, unlawful passengers on a bicycle, is a Class D traffic
11	violation.
12	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 814.460 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to of-
13	fenses that occur on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.
