## House Bill 2232

Sponsored by Representative GREENLICK (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits person under seven years of age from riding motorcycle. Provides exception.

<b>2</b>	Relating to motorcycle passenger safety; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 814.325.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. ORS 814.325 is amended to read:
5	814.325. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a person commits the offense
6	of unlawfully carrying a passenger on a motorcycle if the person carries a person under seven
7	years of age or carries a person [does any of the following]:
8	(a) [Carries On a motorcycle a person] Who is not seated on a permanent and regular seat, if the
9	motorcycle is designed to carry more than one person, or upon another seat attached to the mo-
10	torcycle at the rear or side of the operator's seat.
11	(b) [Carries a person] In a position that interferes with the operation or control of the motor-
12	cycle or the operator's view.
13	(c) [Carries a person] Who is riding, other than in a sidecar or enclosed cab, on a motorcycle
14	with no footrests for that person.
15	(2) A person may carry a person under seven years of age on a motorcycle if:
16	(a) The motorcycle has three wheels;
17	(b) The motorcycle is powered by an electric motor;
18	(c) The motorcycle has an enclosed cab;
19	(d) The motorcycle has a safety belt, safety harness or child safety system for the oper-
20	ator and passenger; and
21	(e) The operator and passenger use the safety belt, safety harness or child safety system
22	in the manner described in ORS 811.210.
23	[(2)] (3) The offense described in this section, unlawfully carrying a passenger on a motorcycle,
24	is a Class B traffic violation.
25	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 814.325 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to of-
26	fenses that occur on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.
