

House Bill 2251

Sponsored by Representative GREENLICK; Representative BARKER (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits Department of Transportation from expending moneys for Columbia River Crossing Project until certain conditions are met.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the Columbia River Crossing Project.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law appropriating money or limiting expen-**
5 **ditures, the Department of Transportation may not expend moneys for any purpose related**
6 **to the Columbia River Crossing Project until the following conditions are met:**

7 (1) **The State Treasurer certifies in writing to the Department of Transportation and**
8 **notifies the Legislative Assembly that the department has the moneys needed to cover**
9 **Oregon's share of the related costs of completing the Columbia River Crossing Project in full.**

10 (2) **The Department of Transportation determines, and notifies the Legislative Assembly**
11 **in writing, that the electors of the City of Vancouver, Washington, have approved a ballot**
12 **measure proposing funding to operate and maintain an extension of a regional light rail**
13 **system from the City of Portland into the City of Vancouver.**
