## House Bill 2261

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Creates offense of smoking in motor vehicle while person under age of 17 is in motor vehicle. Punishes by maximum fine of \$90 for first offense, \$180 for second offense and \$360 for third or subsequent offense.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to smoking in a motor vehicle.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of the Oregon Vehicle 5 Code.
  - SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the offense of smoking in a motor vehicle if the person smokes cigars, cigarettes or tobacco in any form in a motor vehicle while a person under 17 years of age is in the motor vehicle.
- 9 (2) The offense described in this section, smoking in a motor vehicle, is applicable on any premises open to the public and is a:
  - (a) Class D traffic violation for a first offense.
  - (b) Class C traffic violation for a second offense.
- 13 (c) Class B traffic violation for a third or subsequent offense.
