SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows community college or state institution of higher education to recover from school district costs of providing remedial education to enrolled students from school district.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to remedial education.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) For the purposes of this section, "remedial education" means a post-**
5 **secondary course designated by a community college or a state institution of higher educa-**
6 **tion listed in ORS 352.002 that is designed to bring underprepared students to the level of**
7 **skill competency expected of an incoming first-year college student.**

8 **(2) Community colleges and state institutions of higher education may recover from a**
9 **school district in this state the cost of providing remedial education to an enrolled student**
10 **if the student received a high school diploma from a school in the school district.**

11 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act first applies to the 2012-2013 school year.**
