SUMMARY

Allows community college or state institution of higher education to recover from school district costs of providing remedial education to enrolled students from school district.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to remedial education.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) For the purposes of this section, "remedial education" means a post-
5	secondary course designated by a community college or a state institution of higher educa-
6	tion listed in ORS 352.002 that is designed to bring underprepared students to the level of
7	skill competency expected of an incoming first-year college student.
8	(2) Community colleges and state institutions of higher education may recover from a
9	school district in this state the cost of providing remedial education to an enrolled student
10	if the student received a high school diploma from a school in the school district.
11	SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act first applies to the 2012-2013 school year.

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
