SUMMARY

Requires telecommunications contract between telecommunications utility and residential customer to allow customer to terminate contract without penalty if customer enters hospice program.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 759.
5	SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "hospice program" has the meaning given tha
6	term in ORS 443.850.
7	(2) A telecommunications utility may not enter into a contract for provision of telecom
8	munications services with a residential customer in this state for a period exceeding three
9	months unless the contract includes a provision allowing the customer to terminate the
10	contract without penalty if the customer enters a hospice program.
11	SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2011 Act applies to all contracts between telecommuni
12	cations utilities and residential customers entered into or renewed on or after the effective
13	date of this 2011 Act.
