SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires Department of [*Corrections*] **Public Safety Standards and Training** to adopt rules establishing minimum requirements for maintenance of certification as corrections officer.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

2 Relating to certification of corrections officers; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training shall adopt rules**
5 **establishing the minimum requirements, including continuing training and education, for a**
6 **corrections officer employed by the Department of Corrections to maintain certification un-**
7 **der ORS 181.610 to 181.712.**

8 **SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
9 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
10 **on its passage.**
