

# House Bill 2363

Ordered printed by the Speaker pursuant to House Rule 12.00A (5). Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Business and Labor)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates violation of selling or dispensing blunt wraps. Punishes by maximum of \$360 fine.  
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to blunt wraps; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "blunt wrap" means an individual tobacco wrap-**  
5 **per, by whatever name known, that is designed to be sold to individuals and that is made**  
6 **wholly or in part from tobacco, including reconstituted tobacco, whether in the form of a**  
7 **tobacco leaf, sheet or tube.**

8 **(2) A person may not sell or dispense blunt wraps.**

9 **(3) Violation of subsection (2) of this section is a Class B violation.**

10 **SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**  
12 **on its passage.**
