A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to medical imaging.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Oregon Health Policy Board shall convene a work group to investigate

5 and develop recommended strategies to reduce the number of unnecessary advanced medical

6 imaging tests ordered, including but not limited to magnetic resonance imaging and

7 cathode-ray tube scans.

8 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2011 Act is repealed January 2, 2013.
