5	SECTION 1. ORS 743A.080 is amended to read:
6	743A.080. (1) All health benefit plans as defined in ORS 743.730 must provide payment or re-
7	imbursement for expenses associated with:
8	(a) In vitro fertilization;
9	(b) Pregnancy care, as defined by ORS 743.845[,]; and
10	(c) Childbirth.
11	(2) Benefits provided under this section [shall] must be extended to all enrollees[,] and enrolled
12	spouses [and enrolled dependents].
13	(3) Benefits provided under subsection (1)(b) and (c) of this section must be extended to
l4	all enrolled dependents.
15	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 743A.080 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to
16	health benefit plan policies or certificates issued or renewed on or after the effective date
17	of this 2011 Act.

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
