

# House Bill 2379

Ordered printed by the Speaker pursuant to House Rule 12.00A (5). Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Health Care)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires health benefit plan to cover in vitro fertilization.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to insurance coverage of in vitro fertilization; creating new provisions; and amending ORS  
3 743A.080.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 743A.080 is amended to read:

6 743A.080. (1) All health benefit plans as defined in ORS 743.730 must provide payment or re-  
7 imbursement for expenses associated with:

8 (a) **In vitro fertilization;**

9 (b) Pregnancy care, as defined by ORS 743.845[.]; and

10 (c) Childbirth.

11 (2) Benefits provided under this section [*shall*] **must** be extended to all enrollees[,] **and** enrolled  
12 spouses [*and enrolled dependents*].

13 (3) **Benefits provided under subsection (1)(b) and (c) of this section must be extended to**  
14 **all enrolled dependents.**

15 **SECTION 2.** The amendments to ORS 743A.080 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to  
16 health benefit plan policies or certificates issued or renewed on or after the effective date  
17 of this 2011 Act.
