## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to reimburse patient centered primary care homes for services provided to medical assistance recipients.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to medical assistance coverage of patient centered primary care home services; amending
ORS 414.760.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 414.760 is amended to read:

6 414.760. (1) [As funds are available,] The Oregon Health Authority [may] shall provide re-

7 imbursement in the state's medical assistance program for services provided by patient centered

8 primary care homes. If practicable, efforts to align financial incentives to support patient centered

9 primary care homes for enrollees in medical assistance programs should be aligned with efforts of

10 the learning collaborative described in ORS 442.210 (3)(d).

(2) The authority may reimburse patient centered primary care homes for interpretive services
provided to people in the state's medical assistance programs if interpretive services qualify for
federal financial participation.

(3) The authority shall require patient centered primary care homes receiving these reimburse ments to report on quality measures described in ORS 442.210 (1)(c).

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
