SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires hospitals to expend 10 percent of community benefit funds on public health infrastructure.

2	Relating to community benefits provided by hospitals.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 442.
5	SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Health Authority may not renew a license for a hospital
6	under ORS 441.025 if the community benefit report submitted by the hospital under ORS
7	442.205 fails to demonstrate that at least 10 percent of community benefit funds expended
8	by the hospital in the previous 12 months were expended on public health infrastructure.
9	(2) The Oregon Health Policy Board shall prescribe by rule the definition of "public health
10	infrastructure."
11	SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2011 Act applies to applications for renewals of licenses
12	submitted on or after January 1, 2013.
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
