SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs certain state agencies to partner with Oregon Military Department to provide reintegration services for veterans.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to reintegration of veterans; and declaring an emergency.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Department of Human Services, the Department of Transportation, the

5 Housing and Community Services Department, the Employment Department, the Depart-

6 ment of Justice, the Judicial Department, the Oregon University System, the Bureau of La-

7 bor and Industries, the Department of Community Colleges and Workforce Development and

8 the Department of Veterans' Affairs shall partner with the Oregon Military Department to

9 provide reintegration services for veterans throughout this state through regional strategies.

10 SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect on its passage.
