

House Bill 2410

Ordered printed by the Speaker pursuant to House Rule 12.00A (5). Pre-session filed (at the request of House Interim Committee on Veterans and Emergency Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires board of education of community college district to develop standards for community college to implement to give credit for education and training obtained by person while serving in Armed Forces of United States. Directs board of education of community college district to develop methods for informing persons of opportunity to receive credit.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 341.533 is amended to read:

6 341.533. (1) [*A community college may*] **The board of education of each community college**
7 **district, in consultation with the Department of Veterans' Affairs, shall develop standards**
8 **for the community college of the district to implement to give credit for education and training**
9 obtained by a person while [*serving*] **the person served** in the Armed Forces of the United States,
10 as defined in ORS 341.529. The **community college must give credit for** education and training
11 [*for which credit may be given must meet*] **that meets** the standards adopted by the board [*of edu-*
12 *cation of the community college district*].

13 **(2) The board of education of a community college district, in consultation with the De-**
14 **partment of Veterans' Affairs, shall develop methods for informing persons who served in**
15 **the Armed Forces of the United States about how credit may be received as provided by**
16 **subsection (1) of this section.**
