Allows person holding concealed handgun license to operate all-terrain vehicle while carrying loaded handgun.

- 2 Relating to all-terrain vehicles; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 821.240.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - **SECTION 1.** ORS 821.240 is amended to read:
 - 821.240. (1) A person commits the offense of operating a snowmobile or an all-terrain vehicle while carrying a firearm or bow if the person operates any snowmobile or all-terrain vehicle with a firearm in the possession of the person, unless the firearm is unloaded, or with a bow in the possession of the person, unless all arrows are in a quiver.
 - (2) This section does not prohibit a person from operating an all-terrain vehicle while carrying a loaded handgun if the person is licensed under ORS 166.291 and 166.292 to carry a concealed handgun.
 - [(2)] (3) The offense described in this section, operating a snowmobile or an all-terrain vehicle while carrying a firearm or bow, is a Class B traffic violation.
 - SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 821.240 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to offenses committed on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.
