SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Secretary of State to conduct performance audit of Department of Revenue revenue collection and enforcement functions every four years.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "performance audit" has the meaning given that**
5 **term in ORS 297.070.**

6 **(2) The Secretary of State shall conduct a performance audit of the revenue collection**
7 **and enforcement functions of the Department of Revenue at least once every four years. The**
8 **Secretary of State shall conduct the audit in the manner prescribed by ORS 297.070.**

9 **SECTION 2. The Secretary of State shall conduct its first performance audit under sec-**
10 **tion 1 of this 2011 Act prior to July 1, 2012.**
