

House Bill 2590

Sponsored by Representative SCHAUFLEER; Representative MATTHEWS (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows holder of full on-premises sales license or limited on-premises sales license for alcoholic beverages to choose biennial renewal of license, subject to condition.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to alcoholic beverages; amending ORS 471.294.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 471.294 is amended to read:

5 471.294. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, all licenses under this chapter and
6 renewals thereof shall be issued for a period of one year which shall expire at 12 midnight on March
7 31, June 30, September 30 or December 31 of each year.

8 (2) [*Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section,*] A license issued for the first time to an ap-
9 plicant may be issued for less than a year. The fee for a license issued for less than a year under
10 this subsection is the annual license fee prescribed by ORS 471.311.

11 (3) The term of a temporary letter of authority or license issued under ORS 471.302 or any
12 temporary sales license is the period fixed by the Oregon Liquor Control Commission when the let-
13 ter or license is issued.

14 (4) **A licensee may choose to renew a full on-premises sales license or a limited on-**
15 **premises sales license for a two-year period by paying twice the annual license fee estab-**
16 **lished for the license in ORS 471.311, plus the amount of any applicable processing fee**
17 **established in ORS 471.311, unless the commission has reasonable grounds to believe that**
18 **refusal of the license may be justified under ORS 471.313 or that cancellation or suspension**
19 **of the license may be justified under ORS 471.315.**
