## House Bill 2616

Sponsored by Representative SCHAUFLER (at the request of Louise Calder) (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Department of Human Services to issue foster home certification to persons operating single foster home upon proof of compliance with specific training and experience requirements. Limits operation of foster home by multiple foster parents to four nonrelated children. Permits renewal of certification upon proof of compliance with training requirements by one of multiple foster parents.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to certification of foster homes.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 418.625 to 418.645.
  - SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 418.635 and 418.640, the Department of Human Services shall issue a certificate to operate a foster home to two or more persons who together maintain, or seek to maintain, a single foster home if each person provides the department with documentary evidence that:
  - (a) Each person has completed at least 150 hours of training approved by the department as appropriate and necessary foster parent training within the past two years; and
  - (b) Each person has provided foster care in this state for at least the last 10 consecutive years.
  - (2) A certificate issued under this section may not permit foster care of more than four children who are not related to the foster parents to whom the certificate is issued.
  - (3) Once a certificate under this section has been issued, the certificate may be renewed if at least one of the certified foster parents complies with the continuing training requirements required by the department for renewal of a certificate to operate a foster home.
  - (4) Except as otherwise provided in this section, persons applying for a certificate to operate a foster home under this section must comply with all other requirements for issuance of a certificate to operate a foster home under ORS 418.625 to 418.645.
