## House Bill 2617

Sponsored by Representative SCHAUFLER (at the request of Association of Engineering Employees of Oregon) (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Allows state to impose unpaid furlough days on state employee only if employee's position is funded from General Fund.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to unpaid furlough days for certain state employees; and declaring an emergency.
  - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
    - <u>SECTION 1.</u> A state employee may be required to take unpaid furlough days for the purpose of reducing the labor costs of this state only if the employee's position is funded in whole or in part by moneys from the General Fund.
    - <u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect on its passage.
