

House Bill 2617

Sponsored by Representative SCHAUFLER (at the request of Association of Engineering Employees of Oregon)
(Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows state to impose unpaid furlough days on state employee only if employee's position is funded from General Fund.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to unpaid furlough days for certain state employees; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. A state employee may be required to take unpaid furlough days for the**
5 **purpose of reducing the labor costs of this state only if the employee's position is funded in**
6 **whole or in part by moneys from the General Fund.**

7 **SECTION 2. This 2011 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
8 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2011 Act takes effect**
9 **on its passage.**
