

House Bill 2723

Sponsored by Representative TOMEI (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits holder of off-premises sales license from selling alcoholic beverages by means that avoid or allow avoidance of cashier participation in transaction.

Makes violation subject to maximum of \$6,250 fine, one years' imprisonment, or both.

2 Relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 471.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "self-checkout system" means an automated or**
6 **customer-operated point of sale that avoids or allows the avoidance of active and direct**
7 **participation in the purchase transaction by a cashier.**

8 **(2) The holder of an off-premises sales license may not allow a customer to purchase al-**
9 **coholic beverages through the use of a self-checkout system.**
