

House Bill 2746

Sponsored by Representative BOONE (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits State Parks and Recreation Department from requiring certain organizations to pay percentage of receipts of concessions sold at state parks and certain other areas.

2 Relating to the State Parks and Recreation Department.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 390.**

5 **SECTION 2. If an organization described in section 501(c)(3) or (6) of the Internal Re-**
6 **venue Code sells concessions at state parks, waysides and scenic, historic and state recre-**
7 **ation areas, recreational grounds and places acquired by the state for scenic, historic,**
8 **natural, cultural or recreational purposes that are under the jurisdiction and authority of**
9 **the State Parks and Recreation Department pursuant to ORS 390.111 (2), the department**
10 **may not require that the organization pay a percentage of the gross concessions receipts to**
11 **the department.**
