SUMMARY

Prohibits State Parks and Recreation Department from requiring certain organizations to pay percentage of receipts of concessions sold at state parks and certain other areas.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to the State Parks and Recreation Department. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 390. 4 SECTION 2. If an organization described in section 501(c)(3) or (6) of the Internal Re-5 venue Code sells concessions at state parks, waysides and scenic, historic and state recre-6 ation areas, recreational grounds and places acquired by the state for scenic, historic, 7 8 natural, cultural or recreational purposes that are under the jurisdiction and authority of the State Parks and Recreation Department pursuant to ORS 390.111 (2), the department may not require that the organization pay a percentage of the gross concessions receipts to 10 the department. 11 12
