

House Bill 2763

Sponsored by Representative THATCHER (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies crime of disorderly conduct in second degree to expressly include intentionally making false report that results in Amber Plan alert.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to crime; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 166.025.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 166.025 is amended to read:

166.025. (1) A person commits the crime of disorderly conduct in the second degree if[,]:

(a) With intent to cause public inconvenience, annoyance or alarm, or recklessly creating a risk thereof, the person:

[(a)] (A) Engages in fighting or in violent, tumultuous or threatening behavior;

[(b)] (B) Makes unreasonable noise;

[(c)] (C) Disturbs any lawful assembly of persons without lawful authority;

[(d)] (D) Obstructs vehicular or pedestrian traffic on a public way;

[(e)] (E) Congregates with other persons in a public place and refuses to comply with a lawful order of the police to disperse;

[(f)] (F) Initiates or circulates a report, knowing it to be false, concerning an alleged or impending fire, explosion, crime, catastrophe or other emergency; or

[(g)] (G) Creates a hazardous or physically offensive condition by any act which the person is not licensed or privileged to do; **or**

(b) With the intent to initiate an alert under the Amber Plan described in ORS 181.035, knowingly makes a false report to a law enforcement official that causes an alert to be issued under the Amber Plan.

(2) Disorderly conduct in the second degree is a Class B misdemeanor.

SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 166.025 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply to conduct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
