SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prescribes percentage of reimbursement for traffic safety education course that public school may retain.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to traffic safety education courses; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 336.815. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. ORS 336.815 is amended to read: 4 336.815. (1) Any public school may contract with a commercial driver training school for the 5 6 instruction of students enrolled in a traffic safety education course. 7 (2) A public school that enters into a contract with a commercial driver training school 8 may not retain more than 25 percent of the amount reimbursed by the Department of 9 Transportation as provided by ORS 336.805. SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 336.815 by section 1 of this 2011 Act apply only to 10 reimbursements for students beginning a traffic safety education course on or after the ef-11 12 fective date of this 2011 Act. 13
