

# House Bill 2781

Sponsored by Representative THATCHER (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Authorizes state to condemn property possessed by federal government unless property was acquired with consent of Legislative Assembly and in accordance with Article I, section 8, clause 17 of United States Constitution.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to eminent domain.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 35.**

5 **SECTION 2. In addition to any other property that may be condemned under this chap-**  
6 **ter, the state may condemn property possessed by the federal government unless the prop-**  
7 **erty was acquired by the federal government with the consent of the Legislative Assembly**  
8 **and in accordance with Article I, section 8, clause 17 of the United States Constitution.**
