Prohibits public body from releasing information that identifies holder of or applicant for concealed handgun license. Authorizes disclosure for criminal justice purposes or pursuant to court order.

2	Relating to records of concealed handgun licenses.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. A public body as defined in ORS 192.410 may not disclose records or infor-
5	mation that identifies a person as a current holder of, or applicant for, a concealed handgun
6	license unless:
7	(1) The disclosure is made to another public body and is necessary for criminal justice
8	purposes;
9	(2) A court enters an order in a pending civil or criminal case directing the public body
10	to disclose the records or information; or
11	(3) The holder of, or applicant for, the concealed handgun license consents to the disclo-
12	sure.
