

House Bill 2829

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits sale of certain consumer goods by self-checkout device.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to self-checkout devices.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:

(a) **"Retail seller"** means any person who is engaged in the business of selling, offering for sale or otherwise dispensing to consumers one or more of the consumer goods listed in subsection (2) of this section, either alone or in conjunction with other consumer goods or services.

(b) **"Self-checkout device"** means any equipment or machine designed to permit a consumer to initiate and complete a purchase transaction of consumer goods on the premises of a business operated or owned by a retail seller.

(2) **A retail seller may not sell or dispense cigarettes, tobacco products as defined in ORS 323.500 (14), alcoholic beverages or over-the-counter or prescription pharmaceuticals to a consumer through the use of a self-checkout device.**

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
