Makes Governor state's official representative to promote international trade with Oregon. Makes Secretary of State official representative to promote international trade when Governor is unable to serve that function.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) The State of Oregon's official representative for purposes of promoting
5	international trade is:
6	(a) The Governor; or
7	(b) The Secretary of State in the event and for such period of time as the Governor is
8	unable to serve as the state's official representative under this section.
9	(2) As used in this section, "international trade" has the meaning given that term in ORS
10	285A.010.
