

House Bill 2870

Sponsored by Representative CLEM (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Makes Governor state's official representative to promote international trade with Oregon. Makes Secretary of State official representative to promote international trade when Governor is unable to serve that function.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to promotion of international trade.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The State of Oregon's official representative for purposes of promoting**
5 **international trade is:**

6 **(a) The Governor; or**

7 **(b) The Secretary of State in the event and for such period of time as the Governor is**
8 **unable to serve as the state's official representative under this section.**

9 **(2) As used in this section, "international trade" has the meaning given that term in ORS**
10 **285A.010.**
