

House Bill 2878

Sponsored by Representative LINDSAY (at the request of Jim Hill) (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Human Services to conduct home study of prospective adoptive parent who applies to department for adoption services and who currently is under study or consideration by another public or private agency for placement of child for adoption.

2 Relating to adoption services.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall conduct a home study, as defined**
5 **in ORS 109.304, of a prospective adoptive parent who applies to the department for adoption**
6 **services and who is currently under study or consideration by another public or private**
7 **agency for placement of a child for adoption.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2011 Act applies to applications for adoption services sub-**
9 **mitted to the Department of Human Services on or after the effective date of this 2011 Act.**
