

House Bill 2889

Sponsored by Representative J SMITH (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Revenue to prepare and mail to taxpayers "Oregon Annual Review," describing how state has spent tax revenues in preceding calendar year.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to annual report to taxpayers.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "Oregon Annual Review" means a publication**
5 **that describes the manner in which the state has spent tax revenues in the preceding cal-**
6 **endar year and the number of people who have been served.**

7 **(2) The Department of Revenue shall cause the Oregon Annual Review to be compiled and**
8 **printed annually. On or before October 15 of each year, beginning in 2012, the department**
9 **shall mail a copy of the Oregon Annual Review to each taxpayer at the taxpayer's last ad-**
10 **dress known to the department.**
