House Bill 2891

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon to sponsor and support establishment of community-based initiative to provide volunteer transit foot patrols.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to light rail.
Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon shall sponsor and support the establishment of a community-based initiative to provide volunteer transit foot patrols to monitor areas of the light rail system that are accessible by members of the public.

- (2) In establishing transit foot patrols, the district may cooperate with existing community-based organizations including, but not limited to, neighborhood associations.
- (3) Transit foot patrol volunteers do not have authority to participate actively in law enforcement or in measures taken by district personnel to enforce district security policy. A transit foot patrol volunteer who observes a violation of law or district security policy shall report the observations to the appropriate law enforcement official or district personnel.
