

# House Bill 2891

Sponsored by Representative J SMITH (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon to sponsor and support establishment of community-based initiative to provide volunteer transit foot patrols.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to light rail.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon shall**  
5 **sponsor and support the establishment of a community-based initiative to provide volunteer**  
6 **transit foot patrols to monitor areas of the light rail system that are accessible by members**  
7 **of the public.**

8 **(2) In establishing transit foot patrols, the district may cooperate with existing**  
9 **community-based organizations including, but not limited to, neighborhood associations.**

10 **(3) Transit foot patrol volunteers do not have authority to participate actively in law**  
11 **enforcement or in measures taken by district personnel to enforce district security policy.**  
12 **A transit foot patrol volunteer who observes a violation of law or district security policy**  
13 **shall report the observations to the appropriate law enforcement official or district person-**  
14 **nel.**
