

# House Bill 2897

Sponsored by Representative KENNEMER (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates subtraction from taxable income for mileage of volunteers.  
Applies to tax years beginning on or after January 1, 2012.  
Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to income tax subtractions for mileage of volunteers; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2011 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 316.**

5 **SECTION 2. In addition to the other modifications to federal taxable income contained**  
6 **in this chapter, a taxpayer is allowed a subtraction for use of the taxpayer's motor vehicle**  
7 **in the performance of volunteer services. A taxpayer may subtract from federal taxable in-**  
8 **come an amount equal to 10 cents per mile multiplied by the number of miles driven in the**  
9 **performance of volunteer services.**

10 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2011 Act applies to tax years beginning on or after January**  
11 **1, 2012.**

12 **SECTION 4. This 2011 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2011**  
13 **session of the Seventy-sixth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
