House Bill 2901

Sponsored by Representative KENNEMER (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Limits ability of public body to require charitable organization, private foundation trust, split interest trust or private foundation to disclose certain information relating to employees, officers, directors, trustees, members or owners. Limits ability of public body to require private foundation, private foundation trust, split interest trust or any other organization that makes grants to charitable organizations to disclose certain information relating to donees.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to disclosures required by public bodies.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - **SECTION 1.** (1) For the purposes of this section:
 - (a) "Private foundation" has the meaning given in section 509 of the Internal Revenue Code, as in effect on the effective date of this 2011 Act.
 - (b) "Public body" has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.
 - (2) Unless the person has given written consent to the disclosure, a public body may not require that a charitable organization, private foundation trust, split interest trust or private foundation disclose the race, religion, gender, national origin, socioeconomic status, age, ethnicity, disability, marital status, sexual orientation or political party registration of an employee, officer, director, trustee, member or owner of the entity.
 - (3) Unless the person has given written consent to the disclosure, a public body may not require that a private foundation, private foundation trust, split interest trust or any other organization that makes grants to charitable organizations disclose the race, religion, gender, national origin, socioeconomic status, age, ethnicity, disability, marital status, sexual orientation or political party registration of:
 - (a) A person that has received or will receive money or in-kind contributions from the foundation, trust or organization; or
 - (b) An employee, officer, director, trustee, member or owner of an entity that has received or will receive money or in-kind contributions from the foundation, trust or organization.
