

# House Bill 2902

Sponsored by Representative KENNEMER (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Limits ability of public body to impose requirements for governing board or officers of charitable organization, private foundation trust, split interest trust or private foundation.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to requirements imposed by public bodies for the governing bodies of certain private enti-  
3 ties.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. (1) For the purposes of this section:**

6 (a) **"Private foundation" has the meaning given in section 509 of the Internal Revenue**  
7 **Code, as in effect on the effective date of this 2011 Act.**

8 (b) **"Public body" has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.**

9 (2) **A public body may not require that the governing board or officers of a charitable**  
10 **organization, private foundation trust, split interest trust or private foundation include a**  
11 **person of a particular race, religion, gender, national origin, socioeconomic status, age,**  
12 **ethnicity, disability, marital status, sexual orientation or political party registration.**

13 (3) **A public body may not prohibit service by a person as a board member or officer of**  
14 **a charitable organization, private foundation trust, split interest trust or private foundation**  
15 **based on the person's family relationship with another board member or officer, or based on**  
16 **the person's family relationship with a donor.**

17 (4) **A public body may not require that the governing board or officers of a charitable**  
18 **organization, private foundation trust, split interest trust or private foundation include a**  
19 **person who does not have a family relationship with another board member, officer or donor.**
