Limits ability of public body to impose requirements for distribution of funds by charitable organizations, private foundation trusts, split interest trusts and private foundations.

2	Relating to requirements imposed by public bodies for the distribution of funds by certain private

4	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
5	SECTION 1. (1) For the purposes of this section:
6	(a) "Private foundation" has the meaning given in section 509 of the Internal Revenue
7	Code, as in effect on the effective date of this 2011 Act.
8	(b) "Public body" has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.
9	(2) Except to the extent necessary to enforce a condition imposed by a donor of funds
10	a public body may not require that a charitable organization, private foundation trust, spli
11	interest trust or private foundation distribute funds to a person or entity based on:
12	(a) The race, religion, gender, national origin, socioeconomic status, age, ethnicity, disa
13	bility, marital status, sexual orientation or political party registration of the person or of the
14	employees, officers, directors, trustees, members or owners of the entity; or
15	(b) The populations, areas or communities served by the person or entity.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
