

# House Bill 2903

Sponsored by Representative KENNEMER (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Limits ability of public body to impose requirements for distribution of funds by charitable organizations, private foundation trusts, split interest trusts and private foundations.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to requirements imposed by public bodies for the distribution of funds by certain private  
3 entities.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. (1) For the purposes of this section:**

6 (a) **"Private foundation" has the meaning given in section 509 of the Internal Revenue**  
7 **Code, as in effect on the effective date of this 2011 Act.**

8 (b) **"Public body" has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.**

9 (2) **Except to the extent necessary to enforce a condition imposed by a donor of funds,**  
10 **a public body may not require that a charitable organization, private foundation trust, split**  
11 **interest trust or private foundation distribute funds to a person or entity based on:**

12 (a) **The race, religion, gender, national origin, socioeconomic status, age, ethnicity, disa-**  
13 **bility, marital status, sexual orientation or political party registration of the person or of the**  
14 **employees, officers, directors, trustees, members or owners of the entity; or**

15 (b) **The populations, areas or communities served by the person or entity.**
