## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Removes limitations on alcohol content, minimum amount, source and place of consumption for malt beverages sold by brewery. Allows brewery to sell malt beverages at retail at one premises other than premises where manufacture occurs. Allows brewery to obtain special events license.]

Modifies alcohol content and quantity restrictions for malt beverages sold by brewery licensee on licensed premises to unlicensed entities.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to brewery licensees; amending ORS 471.220.

**3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:** 

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 471.220 is amended to read:

5 471.220. (1) A brewery license shall allow the manufacture, importation, storage, transportation,

6 wholesale sale and distribution to licensees of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission, and the ex-

7 port of malt beverages. [Except as specifically provided in this section, no brewery licensee shall sell

8 any malt beverages to be consumed on the licensed premises. No brewery licensee shall] A brewery

9 licensee may not sell within the State of Oregon any beer containing more than six percent alcohol

10 by volume. Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, a brewery licensee may not

11 sell malt beverages for consumption on the licensed premises.

12 (2) A brewery licensee may:

(a) Sell malt beverages brewed on the licensed premises for consumption on the licensed prem-ises; and

(b) Sell malt beverages brewed on the licensed premises [and containing not more than eight percent alcohol by volume], in quantities of not less than [five] four gallons, to an unlicensed organization, lodge, picnic party or private gathering. [Such malt beverages shall not be sold by any such unlicensed group.] An unlicensed organization, lodge, picnic party or private gathering may not resell the malt beverages that a brewery licensee sells under this paragraph.
